

# What to Do When You Get Side Effects After Being Vaccinated Against COVID-19

## Possible side effects in the few days after vaccination

Note: Side effects are more likely to appear after the second shot.

- Pain or swelling at the site ⌚ For 2 days from the day of
- Muscle or joint pain ⌚ For a day from the next day
- Headaches ⌚ For a day from the next day
- Fatigue, chills, fever ⌚ For a day from the next day



Tiredness, nausea, diarrhea or vomiting may also occur.

These symptoms **should disappear after a few days**  
**Just wait and keep checking your condition**

### In case of a high fever or strong pain

You may use over-the-counter fever-reducing pain relief medicine, but if you are worried, you should consult with **your doctor**, a **pharmacist** or **pharmacy staff**.
